



BETAVA
A reversible beret

About 200 yards of yarn.
Size #10, 16 in. circular needles
Size #10 ½, 16 in. circular needles
Size #10 ½ double pointed needles

With #10 circular needles, cast on 60 sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker at beginning of round. Work *K1, P1* ribbing for 7 rounds. Change to 10 ½ circular needles.

Increase round:

Knitting around increase 42 sts. evenly spaced for 102 sts. (Increase by knitting in front and back of st.)

Start Top Pattern:

K5, P1, repeating around. Repeat this round until total length from beginning of brim is 6 1/2".

Top Decrease Pattern, changing to double pointed needles when necessary:

Round 1: *K2 tog., K1, K2tog., P1* repeating between *'s around.

Round 2: *K3, P1* around.

Round 3: *K1, K2tog., P1* repeating around.

Round 4: *K2, P1* around.

Round 5: *K2tog., P1* repeating around.

Round 6: *K1, P1* around.

Round 7: *K2tog.* around.

Round 8: Knit around.

Round 9: *K2tog.* around.

Cut yarn. Draw through remaining sts. Pull to close and tie off. Neatly weave in yard ends.

Optional Knot:

With crochet hook, make a chain about 10" long. Fasten and then form chain into 3 loops. Sew loops to top of hat. Make another top knot for reserve top side of hat.
